CONDITIONS FOR REPRODUCTION/PUBLICATION

1. Written permission to reproduce or publish photographic images must be secured from the New Mexico Museum of Art. Permission is granted for **one time use only**. All other rights, including those of further reproduction or publication, are reserved in full by the New Mexico Museum of Art. Possession of a Museum image does not constitute permission to use or publish it.
2. Requests for alterations or variations to the image such as cropping, overprinting or bleeding to edge of any reproduction must be made in writing to the New Mexico Museum of Art.
3. All efforts should be made to make photographic reproductions as faithful and accurate to the originals as possible. Before publication of any reproduction, the New Mexico Museum of Art reserves the right to require a proof for final approval.
4. The New Mexico Museum of Art may require and will furnish exact documentation to accompany each reproduction.
5. The credit line as specified is **MANDATORY**.
 - a. With printed matter, it is preferred that the credit line appear on the same or facing page as the illustrations with other "Sources of Illustrations". Crediting of each individual item is necessary in all cases.
 - b. With films, filmstrips, and video use, it is preferred that the credit line be included with the other "Source of Illustrations". In manuals that accompany filmstrips give credit at the point where the illustration is discussed.
 - c. With exhibitions, it is preferred the credit be shown within exhibition area.
6. Publisher shall furnish the New Mexico Museum of Art without charge two (2) copies of each publication or book in which reproduction appears.
7. Orders will not be processed until payment is received in full; the New Mexico Museum of Art is not responsible for foreign banking fees.
8. The New Mexico Museum of Art gives no exclusive rights to any publisher, author or photographer and assumes no responsibility for duplication of subjects by others.
9. It is the responsibility of the applicant to secure the rights to reproduce the requested images from the appropriate copyright holders.
